Health and Safety Protocols

To ensure the health and safety of our travelers, we have established the following safety measures and procedures throughout your tour.

Before Departure

Because rules and guidelines vary from destination to destination and are continually changing, before you travel, UNIGLOBE will provide you with the most up-to-date information to ensure you are informed about protocols in your destination.

A face covering is required for all passengers upon arrival and while entering and exiting the motor coach. Please bring your own face covering to use while traveling. While limited quantities of face coverings may be available provided by UNIGLOBE, they will not be available for every customer on every trip. UNIGLOBE employees will be wearing face coverings while loading/unloading and anytime walking through the motor coach.

In addition, temperature screenings will occur prior to loading the bus. Any passengers with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be subject to further assessment before being allowed to board.

What to Pack

It is recommended to bring your own face covering (required for select locations) as well as hand sanitizer. We also recommend packing your own snacks, as refreshments will not be provided. Please note that some motor coach companies are requiring passengers to load and unload their own luggage from underneath the bus. Please keep this in mind when packing for your trip.

Motor Coach Expectations

To ensure a clean ride for all guests, motor coach companies are following a strict daily sanitation procedures that include:

- Fully Disinfected Coaches / Drivers will disinfect high-touch areas during stops and layovers
- Masked Driver with Comprehensive Training
- Hand Sanitizer will be available on board at the entrance and lavatory. Travelers are encouraged to carry their own as well.
- Boarding the motor coach will be from back to front and disembarking will be front to back. This will limit the number of people you have to pass through the aisle.
- Drivers will minimize personal contact but, as always, will be at the entrance to the door if anyone needs assistance.
- Seats will be assigned on the bus. Traveling companions will be seated together but social distancing will occur between parties. At this time, a maximum of 30 passengers per bus. Travelers should stay in their designated seats for the length of the trip.
- Travelers will be asked to handle their own luggage. Drivers will wear gloves if assistance is needed.

On the Road

- Once the motor coach is in motion, face coverings may be removed.
- When visiting attractions, all appropriate local safety precautions will be followed and guests may be rotated in smaller sub-groups when necessary.
- Social distancing will be incorporated in some form in most activities and visits.

Social Awareness

- If you are sick or have been exposed, stay home.
- Wash your hands and avoid touching surfaces.
- Maintain space from passengers when on and off the bus.
